'As long as it's credible and necessary for the role. During nude scenes, I don't feel like it's Valmike doing it – the character who I'm playing is and it's him that's naked, so I just get on with it.'

'I'm excited about the new year. Get To Know Me will be doing the rounds at film festivals and Right Hand Drive, an American production, is being released next month. Fingers crossed they'll do well.'
